

## **Home Learning at Richmond Hill Primary Academy**

Learning beyond the classroom is a vital part of ensuring that our pupils succeed and develop. It helps parents see the learning that is happening in class, and gives our pupils the opportunity to extend and deepen their understanding.

Pupils across the school are set a variety of tasks to complete outside of lessons.

### **Home Learning across the school**

**Daily reading at home recorded in your child's planner**, is a key part of their home learning throughout school. Along - side this will be **weekly spellings** to learn appropriate to the age and stage of your child.

### **Key stage 2**

**Literacy home learning** in the form of a weekly task will be issued on a **Wednesday morning** to be handed back to the class teacher the following Monday.

**Mathematics home learning** in the form of weekly tasks or problems will be issued on a **Monday** to be handed back to the class teacher on Friday.

**Homework club is available to all KS2 pupils to complete their homework on Wednesday lunchtime.**

Pupils may wish to record homework tasks in their planner, and use this to ensure that they complete the relevant work on time. The quantity set will vary according to the age / stage of your child, and will be complemented by teachers' feedback.

If pupils are having difficulty completing homework, they should speak to their class teacher at the earliest possible opportunity, the school operates a home learning facility in school each Wednesday where pupils are able to complete home learning set, with staff available too support.
