Some Club Leaders are self-employed providers and not employed by the Academy, but have completed all appropriate vetting procedures and insurance. Dates of clubs are correct at the time of publication. Certain after school clubs include a cost for materials/cooking ingredients.

Please note:- Sessions may be cancelled/re-arranged if the venue/club leader is unavailable. Only under these circumstances will a refund be offered. Refunds will not be made for any other reason unless under exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the Assistant Principal (non-curriculum). Club Leaders are responsible for any 'exemptions' of participants from their club due to behaviour issues or failing to bring the correct equipment (e.g. shin pads for football).
