TRANSITION 2018

We provide an extensive transition programme for all our pupils to enable them to settle more easily into their new classes in September.

Class Swaps Week w/c 9th July – your child will enter/leave school using their current entrances/exits. Parents' Meetings are arranged for parents of pupils moving phases – from Reception to Year 1 and from Year 2 to Year 3. There is also a Parents' Meeting for new Year 6 pupils which includes important information on SATs (Statutory Assessment Tests). New Reception, new Y2, new Y4 and new Y5 parents are invited to Meet the Teacher meetings. **Please enter school through the main school entrance for all the meetings and you will be directed to the appropriate room.** View diary dates for dates/times.

Y6 Transition to Ridgewood w/c Monday 9th July 2018 – for pupils with a confirmed place at Ridgewood School starting September 2018. Information packs from Ridgewood will be distributed to parents via school. It is parents' responsibility to transport their child to Ridgewood each morning, with Ridgewood providing transport back to Richmond Hill following staggered finishing times at the end of the day. ALL pupils will be transported back to Richmond Hill at the end of each day to walk home alone or be collected by parents. On the days that pupils arrive back to Richmond Hill early they will stay in school until 3.30pm and leave via their normal exit the KS2 gate. On the days that they arrive back after 4.00pm they will come back into the school hall for a quick head count before they walk home alone or are collected by parents.

Y6 pupils not going to Ridgewood attend Richmond Hill as normal and work in the Y6 classrooms with new Y6 pupils (current Y5).

Year 6 Pupils' Transfer to Secondary School - Richmond Hill Primary Academy has no influence on class allocations when pupils transfer schools either at primary or secondary level.

Class Allocations for September 2018 - It is the Academy's policy that the allocation of pupils to classes for September is organised by the existing teacher, based on numbers, gender, academic and social groups. Children will be informed of their new classes on Monday 9th July 2018.

Healthy Week w/c Monday 25TH June 2018

Reception/KS1/KS2

Outdoor PE Kits should be brought into school for the five days of Healthy Week, and can be left in the class cloakrooms. Pupils to wear school uniform as normal and get changed into PE kit in school - (with the **exception** of the morning of Tuesday 26th June for Reception/KS1 Sports Day – see below for details)

HEALTHY WEEK

Reception/KS1 – there will be a variety of indoor and outdoor sports for pupils to enjoy giving them an opportunity to experience some of the following activities - ten pin bowling, golf pitch and putt, tag rugby, tennis, kwick cricket, skipping, hoop and ball skills. We've also arranged for the children to have a go on some balance bikes.

KS2 pupils will be involved in an intra-house competition of rounders, football, kwick cricket, basketball. There will also be an opportunity for pupils to experience some of the following sports – tennis, tag rugby, ten pin bowling, taekwondo, cheerleading and orienteering.

SPORTS DAY

General Information about Sports Days for Reception/KS1/KS2

Your child can compete in a t-shirt in their house colour, otherwise their usual white PE top is ok.

Pegasus – Blue Lightning – Yellow Silver – Red Shadowfax - Green

Please ensure your child is adequately protected from the sun (if applicable) and provide them with a sun hat, sun protection (to be applied by themselves) and a drink of water in a labelled drinks bottle.

We will be selling ice-pops to pupils at the end of each session of sports day. Reception/KS1 - if your child would like to enjoy an ice-pop during morning break, following the sporting events, please send them with 10p prior to the morning of the 26th June and give it to their class teacher. KS2 pupils can bring 10p on the morning of sports day and they can purchase their own ice-pop at the end of their sports day.

SPORTS DAY for Reception and KS1

Tuesday 26th June – 9.30am-10.45am approx.

Reception/KS1 children will have the chance to join in with the majority of races, giving parents more opportunity to cheer them on. Each class will have a starting position and race, where chairs will be made available for parents to spectate. When all children have had a turn and points totalled up by the teacher, each class will move on to the next race. You will then be able to follow your child to the seated area of the next race, moving as your child moves on - it would be very much appreciated if parents could stay within the allocated areas. All year groups will then come together for the final 'Relay' race where teachers will have chosen 6 boys and 6 girls from each class to participate.

The event will take place on the school field which parents can access through the Key Stage 2 gate. For health and safety reasons parents will not be allowed through the gates until **9.10a.m.** Please ensure you send your child **already dressed in their outdoor PE kit on sports day with their school uniform in a named bag to get changed into after the conclusion of their sporting events.**

SPORTS DAY for KS2

Tuesday 26th June - 1.30p.m.-3.15p.m. approx.

The event will take place on the school field which parents can access through the Key Stage 2 gate. For health and safety reasons parents will not be allowed through the gates until **1.15p.m.**

Reserve Sports Day for Reception/KS1/KS2

If we have unfavourable conditions for the Sports Day on the 26th, we have a reserve day of Friday 29th June (same times apply). We will contact parents by text as early as possible if it is necessary to re-arrange/cancel.

NURSERY SPORTS DAY

Wednesday 4th July – 2.00pm-2.45pm approx.

This event for **ALL** nursery children will take place on the school field which parents can access through the Key Stage 2 gate. For health and safety reasons, parents will not be allowed through the gates until **1.45pm**. Nursery children should come to school dressed in a white t-shirt, shorts and trainers, tracksuit if applicable, with their school sweatshirt/cardigan. Please ensure your child is adequately protected from the sun (if applicable) and provide them with a sun hat, sun protection and a drink of water in a labelled drinks bottle.

- Beginning of the Week children to be collected at the end of their nursery session at 12.00 noon as normal and return with their parents to join the nursery staff on the school field for 1.55pm at the latest;
- Parents of End of the Week children and 30hrs children are asked to go directly to the school field where your child will be waiting with nursery staff for the start of the event.
