Still needs consistent monitoring to ensure coverage and weekly lessons in some year groups. • Weekly 'Open the Book' assemblies on Bible stories, children across school have begun to recount the stories in Foundation books to provide consolidation and reflection. • Year 4 receiving extra RE lesson during Electives afternoon • Year 5 have 5 week block of visits from Bible Explorers during term 2 • Medium term plans redistributed to ensure all staff know coverage • During Term 1 weekly collective worship themes were created to link with weekly PSED/British value themes, however the latter has been changed, so these are no longer used. • Display created on charitable donations (link to British values) • Better use of permanent displays to be planned to represent each religion 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • RE continues to be taught to Good or better standard. Continue to observe all staff teach RE, providing targets for improvement • Ask staff for children not to just recount Open the Book stories but mainly to reflect on what it teaches us and how the message can be applied to their lives (AT2) • School Prayer competition to be set (provide staff with example of prayers and raise the profile of the competition in assemblies) • Look into possibility of visiting a place of worship (other than a church) during Term 1 • Compile photographs of learning for 6 religions to create permanent posters representing each religion • Resource boxes created for each religion
