One issue raised by a parent focused on parking before and after school. One issue focused on non-enforcement of uniform. One issue stated that Nursery attainment levels had not been sent home, although the child had not yet completed a year in Nursery, and parents had attended two face-to-face meetings where attainment was discussed.

All issues were addressed immediately through personal phone calls home by the class teachers.
