KS2 and KS1 Statutory Assessments:

We would just like to say how very proud we were of each and every one of our children during the assessment period. They were **ALL** such superstars.

Year 1 Statutory Phonics Screen:

Pupils in Year 1 will undertake their statutory phonics screen from next week, w/c 10th June. We are so proud of how well their phonics have developed.

Year 4 Statutory Multiplication Tables Check:

The MTC tests for our Year 4 children started this week and will continue next week w/c 10th June. Again, we are so proud of them mastering times tables along with the ICT skills needed to complete the test in a set amount of time.

Cosy Cove:

Work has now started on Cosy Cove on KS2 to utilise the area for a creative and wellbeing space. This week the new fence has been put up and the rest will develop over the next few weeks. Another exciting area for our children to enjoy.

Forest School KS1:

Sports Day arrangements for ALL Nursery children – Wednesday 19th June

ALL Nursery Children to come to school already dressed in shorts, t-shirts, trainers (does not have to be school uniform PE kit for our nursery children). Plus a suitable top – school cardigan/jumper or tracksuit top/hoodie. Tracksuit bottoms/skins to wear on top of their shorts for their journey to and from school if they want.

Parents/Carers/Grandparents are invited to come along for the 11.00am start. Entry and exit will be via the Key Stage 2 gate which will be accessible 15 minutes prior to the start of the event and 5 minutes after the event has started. In order for everyone to enjoy the event and for safeguarding purposes we ask that spectators remain in the seating area on the school field. Toilet access for visitors will be via the Hillbillies entrance on the Key Stage 2 playground, which will be monitored by a staff member.

Please see below for the arrangements for all nursery children.

<u>30 hours Nursery Children</u> – if your child stays all day in nursery please take your child to Nursery for the start of their session for registration as normal at 8.35am. Lunch-time arrangements will remain the same before they spend their normal afternoon session in nursery.

Beginning of Week Nursery Children should go to Nursery at their normal registration time at 8.35am. Following the end of sports day at about 11.30am parents will be able to collect and take home their child from the nursery staff – please leave the field via the KS2 gate to make your way round to the nursery classroom door via the usual KS1 gate near the front of the school.



End of the Week Nursery Children – please bring your child to the Office via the main school entrance for 10.40am where they will be met by nursery staff. Parents will then need to make their way to the KS2 gate to access the event. Following sports day these children will have lunch with us, before they spend their normal Wednesday afternoon session in nursery. The payment option for this extra lunch will show on your Parentpay account if your child usually has a school dinner. If they normally have a packed lunch please bring that with you and leave it at the Office on your arrival at 10.40am.

Healthy Week for all pupils w/c 24th June (including Sports Days for Pupils in Reception to Year 6)

Healthy week will be taking place during w/c 24th June where pupils will be taking part in a whole week of sporting activities. Mrs Scanlon our PE Lead is busy organising a wide range of activities with different year groups participating in a number of sports including:- tennis, badminton, hockey, tag rugby, dance, yoga, bowling, team building, golf, skipping, throwing & catching, Danish long ball, football, rounders, cricket and basketball.

Throughout the week, the children will be working with staff as well as local sporting providers funded from the school's Sports Premium, to complete the activities. Due to outside agencies coming into school, activities will be taking place outside and although the weather is fine at the moment, we need to be prepared for any changes. Here is a checklist of what your child will need:-

- Nursery Pupils will be involved in some of the sporting activities and will need to come to school to every session they attend during this week, dressed in shorts, t-shirts, trainers (does not have to be school uniform PE kit for our nursery children). Plus a suitable top school cardigan/jumper or tracksuit top/hoodie. Tracksuit bottoms/skins to wear on top of their shorts for their journey to and from school if they want.
- Pupils in Reception to Year 6 to come to school every day dressed in their usual outdoor PE kit – black shorts, white t-shirt and trainers. Plus a suitable top – school cardigan/jumper or tracksuit top/hoodie. Tracksuit bottoms/skins to wear on top of their shorts for their journey to and from school if they want.
- Water bottle;
- Sun hat;
- Raincoat (if applicable);
- Please also ensure you put sun protection on your child before they come to school, to cover the length of the time they are here.

Parents/Carers/Grandparents are invited to come along to join us on the KS2 field.


