## PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE - 9<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2024

I hope this update finds you well. First, I want to express my sincere gratitude for your patience and understanding during our recent cyber attack, which affected our usual communication channels for 10 days. I'm pleased to inform you that our IT team is working diligently to restore the remaining issue with class emails and social media posts within the next two weeks, and we will keep you updated on the progress.

Despite these challenges, we have several exciting developments to share:

## **School Infrastructure Updates**

The substation at the front of school is currently being upgraded by Northern Power, with completion expected before Christmas. This will enable our ground source heating system to become fully operational.

We're delighted to announce that our Community Cosy Cove will be completed this week, following some final planting work by our children. This space will provide an excellent area for mindfulness and calm activities, both during and outside school hours.

The Trust has approved a significant £800,000 roof renovation project focusing on the most crucial areas requiring attention. Work is expected to commence after Christmas, and we will keep you informed of developments.

## **Academic Achievement**

We're proud to share that Mr Lodge's leadership in writing development has gained national recognition. His pupils' work has been published as part of the Opening Doors writing development project, which our school has been involved with over the past two years. Mr Lodge was invited to speak at a prestigious event in London about his leadership in this area, and his personal reflection on this development has been published as part of the project - a remarkable achievement for both him and our school.

Please note:- Nursery - please follow the directions to the waiting area when arriving in the Foundation area.


